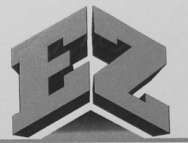

Did you know...

The Riverport Industrial Park's first land sale was in 1984. By 1998 they had their biggest year for land sales by closing on the sale of approximately 200 acres in fourteen separate transactions. Since then, land sales have continued every year in Phases 1 through IV leading to the Park's current size of over 2000 acres with 100 or more companies occupying over 13 million square feet and employing 6000 plus full-time employees. In 2015 Riverport will continue forward with their new Phase V development of 162 acres on south Dixie Highway.

Police Tip What to Do When You are Pulled Over

1. Do not panic, simply pull over at safe stop/location
2. I have always recommended that the person being pulled over acknowledge by a wave of the hand that they see the officer, and activate their emergency flashers. This is often forgotten when being pulled over. It is not mandatory that it is done, but ensures to the officer that you see them, and acknowledge that they wish for you to pull over.
3. If at night turn on your interior light so the officer can see you as they approach.
4. Day or night: Put your vehicle in park, roll down your window, and simply place your hands on the steering wheel of your vehicle.
5. The stopping officer will then instruct you on what they need from you, and when to retrieve it.
6. The stopping officer will also inform you of the reason you are being stopped.
7. The stopping officer will also inform you of their name and badge number should you request

it. Officers are not permitted to refuse this information to a citizen.

8. Should you receive a moving violation from the officer, they will provide a citation to you and will instruct you on the procedures you need to take to address the citation.

9. The officer should then inform you that you are free to go.

It is important to note that often times if an officer pulls you over they are not necessarily going to give you a moving citation. They have the discretion to provide the vehicle operator with a warning on the moving infraction.

It is also important to remember that vehicular stops are extremely dangerous for the Officer making the stop due to traffic, and not knowing who it is they are stopping. Equally, it is dangerous for the citizen being stopped so it is best to do the above for the safety of the citizen in traffic, and to let the officer know you acknowledge that you are aware of being stopped.

Important Phone Numbers

MetroCall 311 is the non-emergency phone number you should use when you have a problem, question, or idea for your local government. It's the place where you can request a service offer a suggestion, register a complaint and even pass on a compliment relating to city services and events.



Q: Who do I call to report a pothole and people who litter?

A: MetroCall 311 or 574-5000. Be ready to give the exact location of the area in need of attention (street address). For people who litter, you need the license plate of the vehicle and a description of the person (ex: tall, blond, female in her thirties). This applies to cigarettes as well.

Is this an Emergency? When to Dial 9-1-1 for an Ambulance


So, when do you call 9-1-1 for an emergency medical response? While individual interpretations of medical emergencies may differ from person to person, the untrained layperson should call EMS for patients experiencing:

- Unconsciousness/Unresponsiveness
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Chest Pains
- Shortness of Breath
- Sudden unexplained pain or weakness in arms, legs or face
- Any alteration in mental status or condition
- Injuries where the patient is incapacitated or cannot move

- Motor vehicle accidents where an injury has occurred

While certainly, not all potential emergencies cannot be listed in a standardized format, as injuries and illnesses vary based on many different factors. However, for non-acute issues, you or the patient may consider other means of care or transport, such as primary care physicians, immediate care centers or clinics that provided care for non-life threatening ailments.

Our emergency medical responders are valuable resources to our community and keeping those resources available to true medical emergencies is not just important – it is absolutely vital to the lives of our neighbors.
